Go Caribbean! Appoints Globally Distinguished Co-Chairs

September 2, 2015 (New York, NY) – Go Caribbean! appoints Ambassador Dr. Angus Friday and Dr. Edward Greene co-chairs for its second Annual International Business and Investment Expo on September 30 & October 1, 2015 at Bank of New York Mellon in New York's Financial District. Other attendees include one of our key strategic partners from Curacao, Raymond Jamanika, Director of Jamanika Consultancy Services, N.V; Wayne Biggs, Jr., Acting Executive Director, United States Virgin Islands Economic Development Corporation; and Barbados Industrial Development Corporation

Ambassador Dr. Angus Friday, Grenada's Ambassador to the Organization of American States, was given his first ambassadorial posting in 2007, representing Grenada at the United Nations. While at the UN, Dr. Friday was a strong advocate for remediation of the effects of global climate change for Grenada and other island nations. In 2009, he went to the World Bank as a specialist in international climate policy, with an emphasis on small island nations and Africa. Dr. Angus Friday was at the World Bank until his appointment to his current role in Washington.

Dr. Edward Green is the former CARICOM Secretariat Assistant Secretary General & United Nations Envoy for HIV/AIDS in the Caribbean. He is Professor Emeritus at the University of the West Indies and is credited with mobilizing the political commitment that contributed to the establishment and sustainability of the Pan Caribbean Partnership (PANCAP) against HIV/AIDS. He chaired the PANCAP Executive Committee (2001-2006) and played an active role on the UN Global Task Team (2005-2007) that championed the cause of universal access to HIV prevention, care and treatment. He was conferred the Life Time Youth Award from the CARICOM Youth Ambassadors Corps that he nurtured during his tenure at the Caribbean Community Secretariat, and is also the recipient of national honors from his homeland, Guyana in 2011 and from Suriname in 2010.
